Cell space, available to prisoners, must comply with medical, spatial and hygiene standards.¹

The national standard for cell space, available to prisoners, is 9m² (in single-occupancy cell) and 7m² (in multiple-occupancy cell).² There are no special rules or standards on further limitation of space available to prisoners in exceptional circumstances.³

Strategy of The Prison Administration of the Republic of Slovenia 2017-2020 (*Strategija Uprave RS za izvrševanje kazenskih sankcij 2017-2020*)⁴ requires that standards for cell space comply with CPT standards.

2016 Report

Recommendations relating to specific prisons: Celje Prison

- V ZPMZ KZ Celje smo predlagali, naj zavod pri nameščanju zaprtih oseb v bivalne prostore upošteva standarde oziroma velikost (kvadraturu) bivalnih prostorov glede na dejansko število nameščenih oseb v posamezni bivalni prostor.⁶ / We proposed to Celje Prison and Juvenile Prison that standards or size (floor area) of living premises be observed when accommodating prisoners regarding the actual number of persons accommodated in an individual room.⁷

Recommendations relating to specific prisons: Maribor Prison:

- Poleg tega smo ZPKZ Maribor – odprti oddelek Rogoza predlagali, naj vodja oddelka in medicinska sestra tudi v prihodnje pregledujeta bivalne prostore in naj se proučijo možnosti uvedbe takšne prakse tudi v drugih ZPKZ oziroma njihovih oddelkih.⁸ / Furthermore, we proposed to Rogoza Open Unit of Maribor Prison that the head of the unit and the nurse continue to inspect rooms and that the possibility of introducing this practice also in other prisons or their units be examined.⁹

Cell space, available to prisoners, must comply with medical, spatial and hygiene standards.¹⁰

Toilets are to be accessible to prisoners at all times.¹¹ During detention, personhood and dignity of the prisoners must be respected; prisoners must be treated humanely, with a view of preserving their physical and mental health.¹² There are no special standards on the location of toilets or privacy protection of prisoners who use toilets.¹³

Strategy of The Prison Administration of the Republic of Slovenia 2017-2020 (*Strategija Uprave RS za izvrševanje kazenskih sankcij 2017-2020*)¹⁴ requires that national standards comply with CPT standards.

Bathing is mandatory upon reception in detention facility; during detention, bathing is mandatory every seven days.¹⁶ Prisoners are required to maintain personal hygiene and the necessary arrangements must be provided. Haircuts and shaving are to be arranged as needed; shaving is mandatory prior to any interrogation or court hearing.¹⁷

During detention, personhood and dignity of the prisoners must be respected; prisoners must be treated humanely, with a view of preserving their physical and mental health. There are no specific national standards on providing privacy to prisoners who use bathing/shower facilities.¹⁸

There are no specific standards on providing cleanly sanitary facilities for detention facilities. General national standards require that facilities satisfy health and sanitary conditions. Contagious Diseases Act (*Zakon o nalezljivih boleznih*)¹⁹ in Art. 9 requires that administrators of housing facilities adopt general measures to satisfy 1. Health standards of potable water, provisions and objects in general use, 2. Quality standards of air in closed spaces, 3. Technical and sanitary maintenance of public facilities, including preventative disinfection, disinsection and deratisation, 4. Waste handling in a way that avoids health hazards and excessive environmental burden.²⁰

General recommendations:²¹

- Nujno je treba v celoti vzpostaviti prilagojene prostore ali oddelke v enem ali več zavodih za prestajanje kazni zapora, da bodo ti primerni za bivanje obsojencev, ki zaradi starosti, bolezni ali invalidnosti potrebujejo dodatno pomoč pri zadovoljevanju osnovnih potreb, ter jih opremiti s prilagojeno opremo, ki omogoča varno

izvajanje aktivnosti ranljivih zaprtih oseb na vseh področjih življenja in omogočala neovirano gibanje, torej brez arhitekturnih ovir (stopnišč in drugih neravnin).

- Nujno bi bilo treba začeti izvajati aktivnosti za zaposlovanje ustreznega negovalnega in oskrbnega osebja za ranljive zaprte osebe, ki (na primer pri vzdrževanju osebne higijene in drugih življenjskih aktivnostih) potrebujejo dodatno pomoč, hkrati pa zaradi varnostnih in drugih razlogov ne morejo biti premeščene v ustrezne socialnovarstvene ali druge ustanove.

2016 Report:

Recommendations relating to specific prisons: Celje Prison

- ZPMZ KZ Celje smo predlagali redno čiščenje kopalnic in opravljanje dezinsekcije.²² / We proposed to Celje Prison and Juvenile Prison that bathrooms be cleaned on a regular basis and disinfection be implemented.²³
- ZPMZ KZ Celje smo še predlagali, naj se v bivalnem prostoru št. 310 preveri ustreznost (funkcionalnost) delovanja vodne armature in popravijo vrata v bivalnem prostoru, da se za bivalni prostor št. 317 prouči možnost namestitve poličke pod ogledalom ter da se v bivalnem prostoru št. 422 namesti zavesa pri kabini za prhanje.²⁴ / We also proposed to Celje Prison and Juvenile Prison that the suitability (functionality) of the water tap be verified, and the doors to the room be repaired in room 310; we also proposed examining the possibility of installing a shelf below the mirror in room 317, and installing a shower curtain in room 422.²⁵
- Poleg tega smo v ZPMZ KZ Celje predlagali, naj se v bivalnem prostoru št. 415 zamenja poškodovana WC-ščetka.²⁶ / We also proposed to Celje Prison and Juvenile Prison that the damaged toilet brush be replaced in room no 415.²⁷

Recommendations relating to specific prisons: Koper Prison

- ZPKZ Koper – oddelek Nova Gorica smo tudi predlagali, naj se zavesa pri prhi odprtega oddelka dejansko namesti in se s tem onemogoči, da bi voda pršila po prostoru, kar bi lahko povzročilo padec zaprte osebe.²⁸ /

We proposed to Nova Gorica Unit of Koper Prison that a shower curtain in the open ward be installed, thus preventing water from spraying all over the bathroom, which could result in prisoners' falling on the floor.²⁹

Recommendations relating to specific prisons: Ljubljana Prison

- ZPKZ Ljubljana smo tudi predlagali, naj se v tuširnici v pritličju pripora prouči možnost popravila pritrjenega okenskega krila, da se bo le ta odpiral in bo s tem omogočeno boljše zračenje prostora.³⁰ / We proposed that Ljubljana Prison to examine the possibility of repairing a fixed casement window in the shower room on the ground floor of the detention unit to enable it to be opened and thus better ventilation of the room.³¹

2015 Report:

Recommendations relating to specific prisons: Koper Prison

- ZPKZ Koper smo opozorili na zastajanje vode v tuš kabini bivalnega prostora št. 231, pri čemer smo že ob obisku prejeli zagotovilo, da bo ta napaka odpravljena.³²

Recommendations relating to specific prisons: Ig Prison

- V ZPKZ Ig smo direktorico že med obiskom seznanili z ugotovljenimi pomanjkljivostmi v sanitarnem prostoru delavnice in hkrati predlagali, da se zamenja steklo okna, ki bo z zunanje strani onemogočal neoviran vpogled v toaletni prostor (WC).³³

Dob

- ZPKZ Dob – polodprti oddelek Slovenska vas smo predlagali, da se stene kopalnice, kjer odpada oziroma se lušči omet, ustrezno sanirajo in da se na talnih odtokih (sifonih) namestijo zaščitni pokrovi, glede na konstantne težave z odpadanjem ometa v izpostavljeni kopalnici pa naj se proučijo možnosti ustreznega zračenja kopalnice in s tem zmanjšanja zadrževanja pare in vlage v kopalnici, kar je lahko eden izmed razlogov težav z odpadanjem ometa.³⁴

Recommendations relating to specific prisons: Maribor Prison

- V ZPKZ Maribor smo predlagali, da se poškodovane vodne armature v čim krajšem času popravijo.³⁵
- ZPKZ Maribor smo predlagali, da zavod poskrbi oziroma organizira, da bodo uporabniki fitnesa po uporabi tuša le-tega tudi redno in ustrezno očistili.³⁶
- V ZPKZ Maribor smo izrazili pričakovanje, da bo v čim krajšem času prišlo do odprave težav z zagotavljanjem tople vode v kopalnicah in da bo urejena napeljava tople vode v vse bivalne prostore zavoda.³⁷

- DPM predlaga, naj zavod obsojencem v I. in III. oddelku znova omogoči popoldansko gibanje na prostem.
- DPM predlaga, naj zavod poskuša uresničiti predloge obsojencev, ki se nanašajo na posodobitev fitnes opreme, nakup gola, žoge, knjig in razdelivcev. DPM predlaga še, naj zavod prouči možnosti za razširitev TV-programске sheme ter uvedbo igranja odbojke ali tenisa, pri čemer naj znova prouči tudi možnosti umestitve šahovskih turnirjev in drugih turnirjev med oddelki.
- DPM predlaga, naj zavod prouči možnost, da bi obsojencem ponudil tudi možnost izobraževanja za pridobitev voznškega dovoljenja (vsaj teoretični del), kot so to predlagali nekateri izmed obsojencev.

General recommendations:⁴⁴

- Glede ZPKZ Ljubljana – oddelek Novo mesto smo izrazili pričakovanje, da bo do realizacije nabave športne opreme prišlo v najkrajšem času.⁶⁹
- ZPKZ Ljubljana – oddelek Novo mesto smo predlagali, da se glede na to, da pripornikom zaradi prostorskih omejitev ni mogoče zagotoviti dela, poskuša omogočiti vsaj več možnosti obiskovanja tečajev oziroma delavnic.⁷⁰

Under Art. 88 of the Enforcement of Criminal Sanctions Act (*Zakon o izvrševanju kazenskih sankcij*),⁷⁵ solitary confinement is a form of disciplinary sanction for convicted prisoners. No solitary confinement in this sense is applicable to prisoners in detention.

However, detained prisoners may be placed in a separate cell if two conditions are met: (i) upon recapture after escape or after being caught during preparations or attempt to escape, (ii) if the prisoner has resisted violently or has otherwise endangered himself or the persons in his vicinity. Prisoner may be hand-cuffed, if necessary to prevent substantial material damage or danger to others.⁷⁶

By virtue of Art. 213č of the Criminal Procedure Act (*Zakon o kazenskem postopku*), Art. 236 of the Enforcement of Criminal Sanctions Act (*Zakon o izvrševanju kazenskih sankcij*) applies,⁷⁷ (1) limiting the time spent to 12 hrs, subject to further extension by periods of 12 hrs, not exceeding a maximum of 72 hrs at a time, if reasons persist; (2) requiring constant supervision, and (3) requiring notification of the medical staff. General rules on time out of cell apply.

Prisoners are subject to mandatory health care insurance, including work-related illness and injury.⁷⁸ Insurance premium and the coverage of health service costs is provided by the state budget.⁷⁹

Medical examination is mandatory within 48 hrs after the reception and prior to leaving detention facility.⁸⁰ Medical examination must be carried out immediately, if there are reasonable grounds that prisoner is suffering from bodily injury, contagious disease or other serious illness.⁸¹

Prisoner's right to choose his medical doctor is limited. Prisoners are provided with health care services in detention facilities' clinic.⁸² Medical treatment outside of detention facilities is authorised by the court upon motion of the facilities doctor. In exigent circumstances, the treatment is authorised by the director of detention facility.⁸³

Prisoner may require a visit and an examination by a medical doctor of his choice, with authorisation of the court and at his own expense.⁸⁴

On medical doctor's recommendation, prisoner may acquire medicine at his own expense, or acquire medicine from his family or other persons.⁸⁵

No specific national standards or rules exist on access to dentist or optician. Access to dentist or optician is governed by general rules on access to medical care.⁸⁶

Recommendations relating to specific prisons - Dob Prison:

- Glede na različno urejenost in ne povsem primerno opremljenost teh prostorov, menimo, da je nujno, da se bolniške sobe uredijo in opremijo v skladu z njihovim namenom in enotno po vseh lokacijah ter da se poskrbi tudi za njihovo primerno prostorsko umestitev (po možnosti v pritličju).⁸⁸
- DPM predlaga, naj zavod znova seznaní ZD Trebnje s priporočilom, da ta uresniči priporočilo izvedenke zdravnice s prejšnjega obiska, da mora biti zdravnik splošne prakse dostopen v prostorih zavoda vsak delovni dan, vsekakor pa ob dnevih sprejema.⁸⁹

General recommendations:

Prison consider the medical expert's recommendation that it would be sensible to arrange (if this is not arranged in another way) after the assessment of medical staff the provision of medication, which the Health Insurance Institute of Slovenia or another insurance company that provides additional insurance does not pay for in full and for which an additional payment is necessary (if such medication is necessary for the maintenance of health and if the person has no financial resources to pay for it).¹⁰¹

Recommendations relating to specific prisons: Radeče

- V PD Radeče je bilo ugotovljeno, da bolniška soba ni opremljena z varnimi oprijemali ali kako drugače, da bi bolni ali invalidni osebi olajšalo bivanje v njej, ter nima možnosti dostopa z invalidskim vozičkom do WC-ja in tuša (vhod v kopalnico je očitno preozek), zato smo predlagali, da se opravi ustrezna prilagoditev tega bivalnega prostora.¹¹²

Recommendations relating to specific prisons: Koper Prison

- ZPKZ Koper smo predlagali, da se v zavodski ambulanti uredi oziroma priskrbi mobilni voziček s kolesci za prevoz pacientov.¹¹³
- V ZPKZ Koper je bilo ugotovljeno, da sta dve medicinski sestri premalo za nemoten potek dela v zavodski/-h ambulanti/-ah, zato smo predlagali, da se proučijo možnosti za zaposlitev dodatne medicinske sestre.¹¹⁴

- V ZPKZ Ig smo izrazili pričakovanje, da so odgovorni v zavodu za december načrtovani pogovor z zobozdravnikom že opravili in zaradi tega smo prosili za sporočilo ugotovitev in morebitnih ukrepov zvezi s tem. Hkrati smo prosili za informacije o tem, kako se zaprtim osebam v praksi zagotavlja dostop do zdravnika (splošne prakse in zobozdravnika) v času, ko zdravnik v zavodu ni navzoč. Zanimalo nas je tudi, kam in kako zaprte osebe sporočijo potrebo za zdravniško pomoč in kdo odloči o tem, če in kdaj bo zaprta oseba deležna zdravniške oskrbe.¹¹⁷

Juvenile prisoners are to be detained separately from adult detainees.¹¹⁸ If interests of the juvenile detainee so dictate, the court may order that s/he be detained together with adult detainees.

Juvenile prisoners are to be provided with care, safety measures and assistance, as required by their age, gender and personality.¹¹⁹

No additional national standards or rules exist.¹²⁰

b)

Special provisions apply to persons who have committed a criminal offence as minors and have not attained the age of twenty-one at the time of institution or conducting of criminal proceedings.

A minor is a person that has not attained the age of 18. Only minors age 14 or above are liable for criminal offences.

Prisoners must comply with the rules set by the Criminal Procedure Act, house rules and guard's orders.¹²¹ Prison guards are required to maintain safety of prisoners, inter alia by preventing conflicts, disciplinary violations and criminal offences.¹²²

Video surveillance system may be installed in detention facilities and used for security and protection of detainees and employees.¹²³ No video surveillance is allowed in changing cabins, elevators, sanitary facilities, cells or bedrooms, with the exception of solitary confinement cell for prevention of self-injury or suicide.

Physical attacks, insulting or indecent behavior of prisoners are disciplinary violations and may be sanctioned by prohibition or restriction of prisoner's correspondence.¹²⁴ If prisoner's conduct amounts to a criminal offence, criminal prosecution will be instituted.

Prisoners may be relocated to a different cell in order to maintain their physical or mental health and respect for their dignity.¹²⁵

Guards are expected to undergo communication skills training and training in use of coercive powers.¹²⁶

Prisoners may make use of supervisory and complaint mechanisms. Complaints may be filed with president of competent district court,¹²⁷ the human rights ombudsman,¹²⁸ diplomatic or consular staff¹²⁹ or the Director General of the Prison Administration of the Republic of Slovenia.¹³⁰

b)

There are no special provisions on protection of LGBTI prisoner. General obligation to protect the dignity of prisoners¹³¹ applies.

1. The president of the competent district court, ie the court competent in the district where detention facilities are located.¹³³ The president or appointed judge must visit detainees on a weekly basis and may, if deemed necessary, make inquiries concerning detention conditions. The president of the district court may make recommendation to the Prisons Administration of the Republic of Slovenia.¹³⁴
2. The Human Rights Ombudsman, acting as the National Preventive Mechanism,¹³⁵ by virtue of Art. 19 of the Optional Protocol.
