Dr. Julia Duchrow has studied law in Saarbrücken, Geneva and Cologne, where she received her law degree in 1996. In 1998 she completed her doctorate with a thesis on the international protection of minority rights. In 2000 she completed the practical part of her legal education in Berlin. Between 2001 and 2011 she was staff member of Amnesty International, Germany, in Berlin and in charge of asylum policies and counter terrorism measures and human rights. From 2011 until 2019 she has been the Head of the Human Rights and Peace Unit of Bread for the World in Berlin. Amongst other topics this unit works on impunity, the protection of human rights defenders, economic, social and cultural rights, business and human rights, migration and development and peaceful conflict resolution. Since 2019 she is Director Policy and Activism and Deputy to the Secretary General of Amnesty International, Germany. The department is responsible for the work on all human rights themes and regions and the mobilisation of members of Amnesty International, Germany. Until 2020 she was member of the

Board of Trustees of the German Human Rights Institute and she is member of the Coordination Committee of the German Human Rights Forum, a NGO coalition with round 55 member organizations working in the field of Human Rights.
