#### INTRODUCTION

Any EU citizen and any natural or legal person residing or having its registered office in the EU has a right of access to the documents held by the Agency, subject to the conditions laid down in Regulation (EC) No 1049/2001 regarding public access to European Parliament, Council and Commission documents (hereafter referred as "the Regulation") and without prejudice to the measures set up in the Decision adopted on 14 December 2012 by the Management Board of the European Union Agency for Fundamental Rights.

This is part of a wider transparency framework of the EU institutions and its efforts to bring EU decision-making closer to citizens.

Here at the Fundamental Rights Agency, a request for public access to documents can be requested through an <u>online form</u> on our website, or by printing a PDF form to send by fax, post or e-mail.


### THE NEW DATA PROTECTION REGULATION FOR THE EU INSTITUTIONS AND BODIES

In 2018 the new data protection regulation, Regulation (EU) 2018/1725, for the EU institutions and bodies was adopted, which entered into force on 11 December 2018. This ensures that personal data is processed in a transparent manner, by providing information and communication relating to the processing of personal data to the individuals concerned in a concise, transparent, intelligible and easily accessible form.




## 1. Analysis on the number of applications received at FRA

In 2019, the number of initial applications decreased by 68% compared to 2018.



In 2019, the number of confirmatory applications decreased by 66% compared to 2018.
