### Additional Information

I graduated from the Faculty of Law, Zagreb University in 1983, and gained my LL D in European law in 2014 at the same Faculty. I passed the Bar Examination in 1986 and Notary Public Examination in 1995.

I was twice elected a judge of the Constitutional Court of the Republic of Croatia for a term of eight years: first in 2007 and second in 2016. In my first mandate I served as the Deputy President of the Court, and in my second term I was again elected to the same position (2016).

My specialisation relates to constitutional law, EU law, law of the Convention for the Protection of Human Rights and Fundamental Freedoms of the CoE. As judge of the Constitutional Court I deal with specific cases of the protection of human rights and fundamental freedoms guaranteed in the Constitution and Convention.

I authored numerous research and scientific papers, and the following books: "The Principle of Proportionality in the Case-

law of European Courts and the Croatian Constitutional Court (with particular emphasis to property issues)" (2016) and "Commentary of the Compensation Act" (1997, co-author). I have participated and presented papers in many national and international scholarly and professional conferences, symposiums and other gatherings.
