In 2012, Ms. Pirovska was appointed as an Executive Director of the Helsinki Committee for Human Rights of the Republic of Macedonia. Prior to this, Ms. Pirovska had served as Head of the Unit for International and Public Relations and Spokesperson of the Ombudsman of the Republic of Macedonia for eight years (2004 – 2012), Advisor to the Ombudsman of the Republic of Macedonia (2004) and Junior Researcher at the Ombudsman's office (1998 – 2004). During her work, she has contributed as an Editor to numerous reports and analyses in the field of human rights and their protection, including the fields of LGBTI, hate crimes, hate speech, and inclusion of Roma people in the National Strategy, amongst others.
